

## Jefferson , West Virginia


Personal income last published on November 15, 2018.

Jefferson is one of 55 [counties](#) in West Virginia. It is part of the Washington-Arlington-Alexandria, DC-VA-MD-WV Metropolitan Statistical Area. Its 2017 population of 56,338 ranked 10th in the state.


### Per Capita Personal Income

In 2017, Jefferson had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$48,569. This PCPI ranked 2nd in the state and was 126 percent of the state average, \$38,479, and 94 percent of the national average, \$51,640. The 2017 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.7 percent from 2016. The 2016-2017 state change was 4.1 percent and the national change was 3.6 percent. In 2007, the PCPI of Jefferson was \$37,987 and ranked 2nd in the state. The 2007-2017 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.5 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 2.6 percent.

### Personal Income

In 2017, Jefferson had a personal income of \$2,736,293.0\*. This personal income ranked 8th in the state and accounted for 3.9 percent of the state total. In 2007, the personal income of Jefferson was \$1,947,389.0\* and ranked 9th in the state.





Percent Contribution to Personal Income





