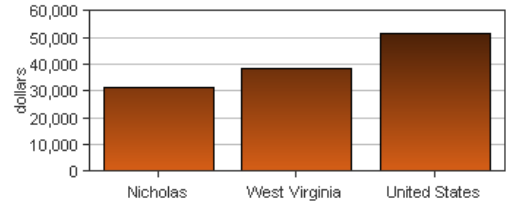
Personal income last published on November 15, 2018.

Nicholas is one of 55 counties in West Virginia. It is not part of a metropolitan area. Its 2017 population of 25,043 ranked 24th in the state.

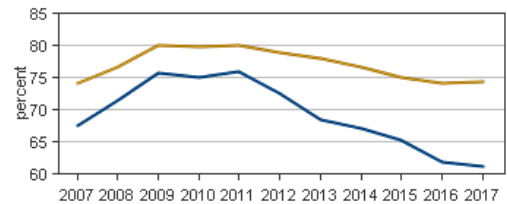
Per Capita Personal Income

In 2017, Nicholas had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,629. This PCPI ranked 38th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$38,479, and 61 percent of the national average, \$51,640. The 2017 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.5 percent from 2016. The 2016-2017 state change was 4.1 percent and the national change was 3.6 percent. In 2007, the PCPI of Nicholas was \$26,897 and ranked 24th in the state. The 2007-2017 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.6 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 2.6 percent.

Personal Income

In 2017, Nicholas had a personal income of \$792,086.0*. This personal income ranked 26th in the state and accounted for 1.1 percent of the state total. In 2007, the personal income of Nicholas was \$702,808.0* and ranked 24th in the state.

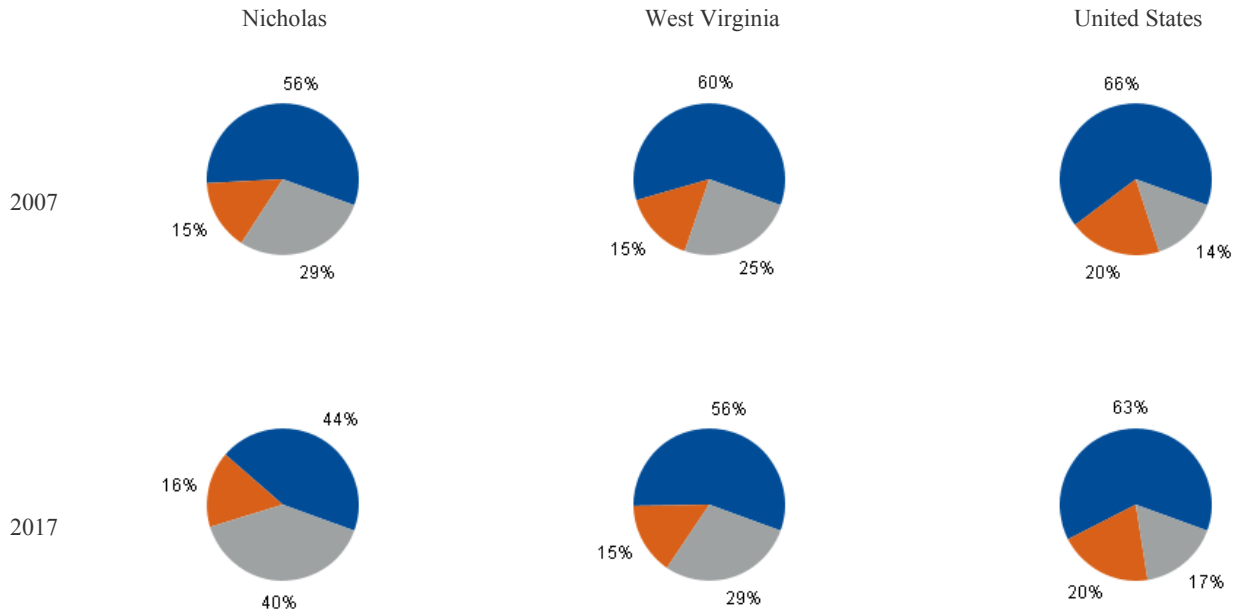
