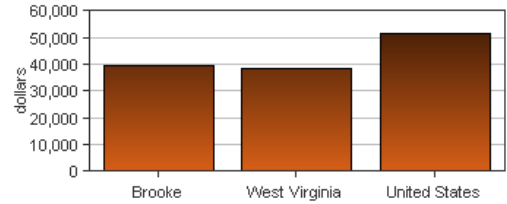
Personal income last published on November 15, 2018.

Brooke is one of 55 counties in West Virginia. It is part of the Weirton-Steubenville, WV-OH Metropolitan Statistical Area. Its 2017 population of 22,443 ranked 28th in the state.

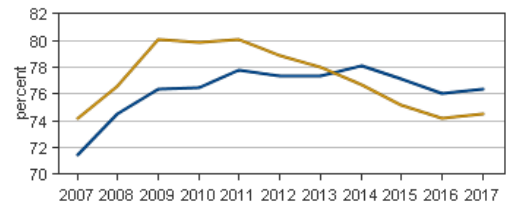
Per Capita Personal Income

In 2017, Brooke had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$39,457. This PCPI ranked 12th in the state and was 103 percent of the state average, \$38,479, and 76 percent of the national average, \$51,640. The 2017 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.1 percent from 2016. The 2016-2017 state change was 4.1 percent and the national change was 3.6 percent. In 2007, the PCPI of Brooke was \$28,469 and ranked 13th in the state. The 2007-2017 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.3 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 2.6 percent.

Personal Income

In 2017, Brooke had a personal income of \$885,527.0*. This personal income ranked 23rd in the state and accounted for 1.3 percent of the state total. In 2007, the personal income of Brooke was \$689,943.0* and ranked 25th in the state.

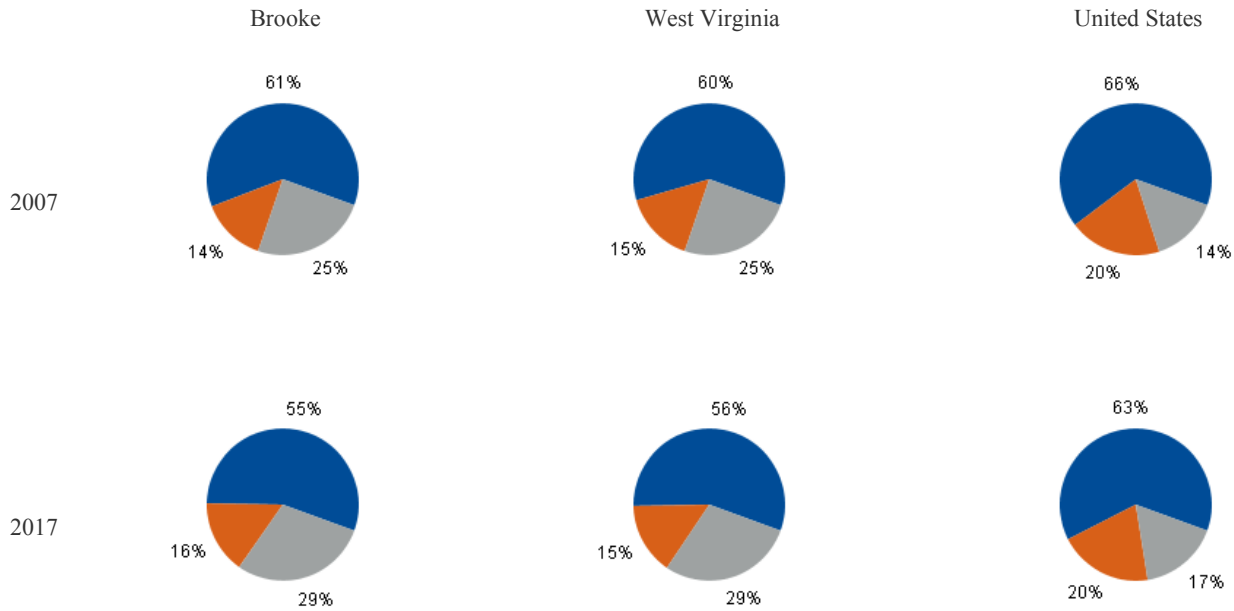
