

# Hardy , West Virginia

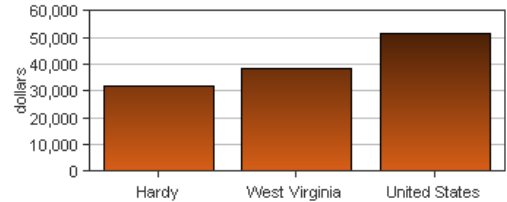
Personal income last published on November 15, 2018.

Hardy is one of 55 counties in West Virginia. It is not part of a metropolitan area. Its 2017 population of 13,717 ranked 40th in the state.

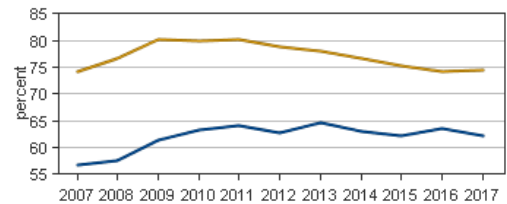
## Per Capita Personal Income

In 2017, Hardy had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$32,148. This PCPI ranked 35th in the state and was 84 percent of the state average, \$38,479, and 62 percent of the national average, \$51,640. The 2017 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.7 percent from 2016. The 2016-2017 state change was 4.1 percent and the national change was 3.6 percent. In 2007, the PCPI of Hardy was \$22,599 and ranked 46th in the state. The 2007-2017 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 2.6 percent.

## Personal Income

In 2017, Hardy had a personal income of \$440,974.0\*. This personal income ranked 39th in the state and accounted for 0.6 percent of the state total. In 2007, the personal income of Hardy was \$312,018.0\* and ranked 40th in the state.

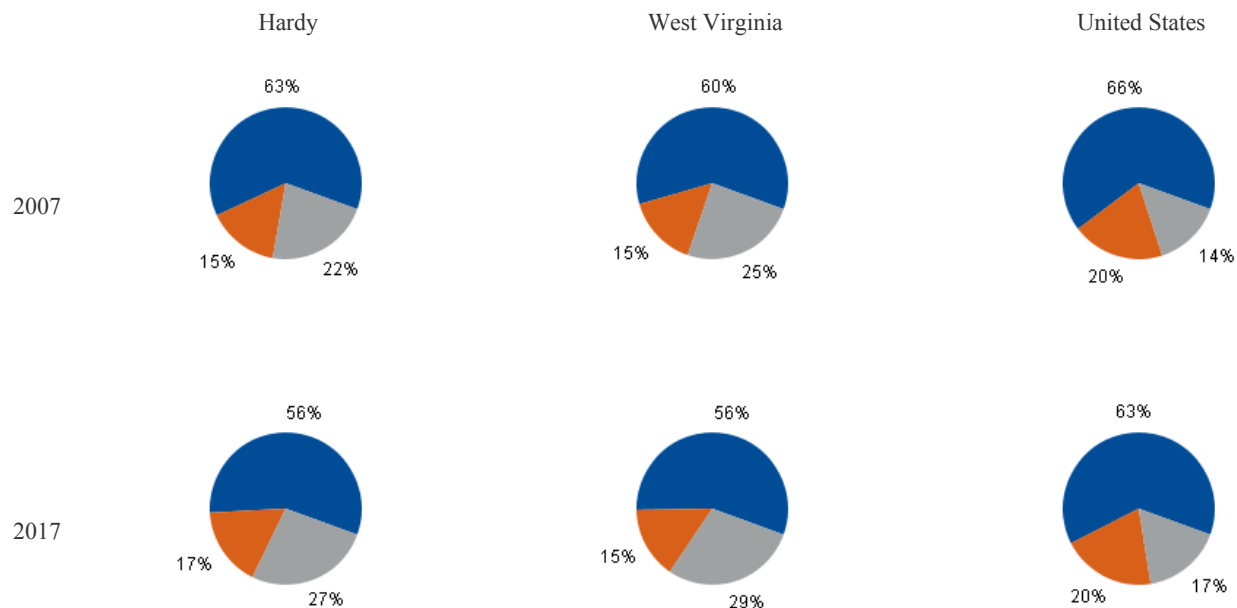
