
Boone is one of 55 counties in West Virginia. It is part of the Charleston, WV Metropolitan Statistical Area. Its 2017 population of 22,349 ranked 29th in the state.

## Per Capita Personal Income


In 2017, Boone had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,368. This PCPI ranked 39th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$38,479, and 61 percent of the national average, \$51,640. The 2017 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.8 percent from 2016. The 2016-2017 state change was 4.1 percent and the national change was 3.6 percent. In 2007, the PCPI of Boone was \$26,055 and ranked 26th in the state. The 2007-2017 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.9 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 2.6 percent.

## Personal Income

In 2017, Boone had a personal income of \$701,048.0\*. This personal income ranked 29th in the state and accounted for 1.0 percent of the state total. In 2007, the personal income of Boone was \$654,359.0\* and ranked 27th in the state.



