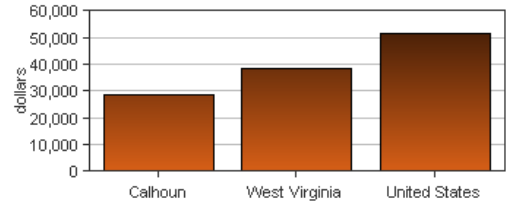
Personal income last published on November 15, 2018.

Calhoun is one of 55 counties in West Virginia. It is not part of a metropolitan area. Its 2017 population of 7,307 ranked 52nd in the state.

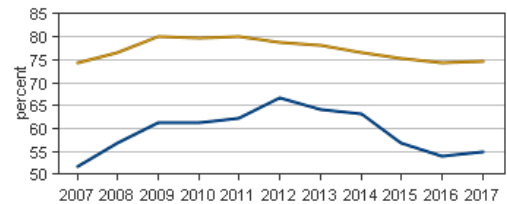
Per Capita Personal Income

In 2017, Calhoun had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,392. This PCPI ranked 52nd in the state and was 74 percent of the state average, \$38,479, and 55 percent of the national average, \$51,640. The 2017 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.4 percent from 2016. The 2016-2017 state change was 4.1 percent and the national change was 3.6 percent. In 2007, the PCPI of Calhoun was \$20,578 and ranked 52nd in the state. The 2007-2017 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.3 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 2.6 percent.

Personal Income

In 2017, Calhoun had a personal income of \$207,462.0*. This personal income ranked 54th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 2007, the personal income of Calhoun was \$156,148.0* and ranked 52nd in the state.

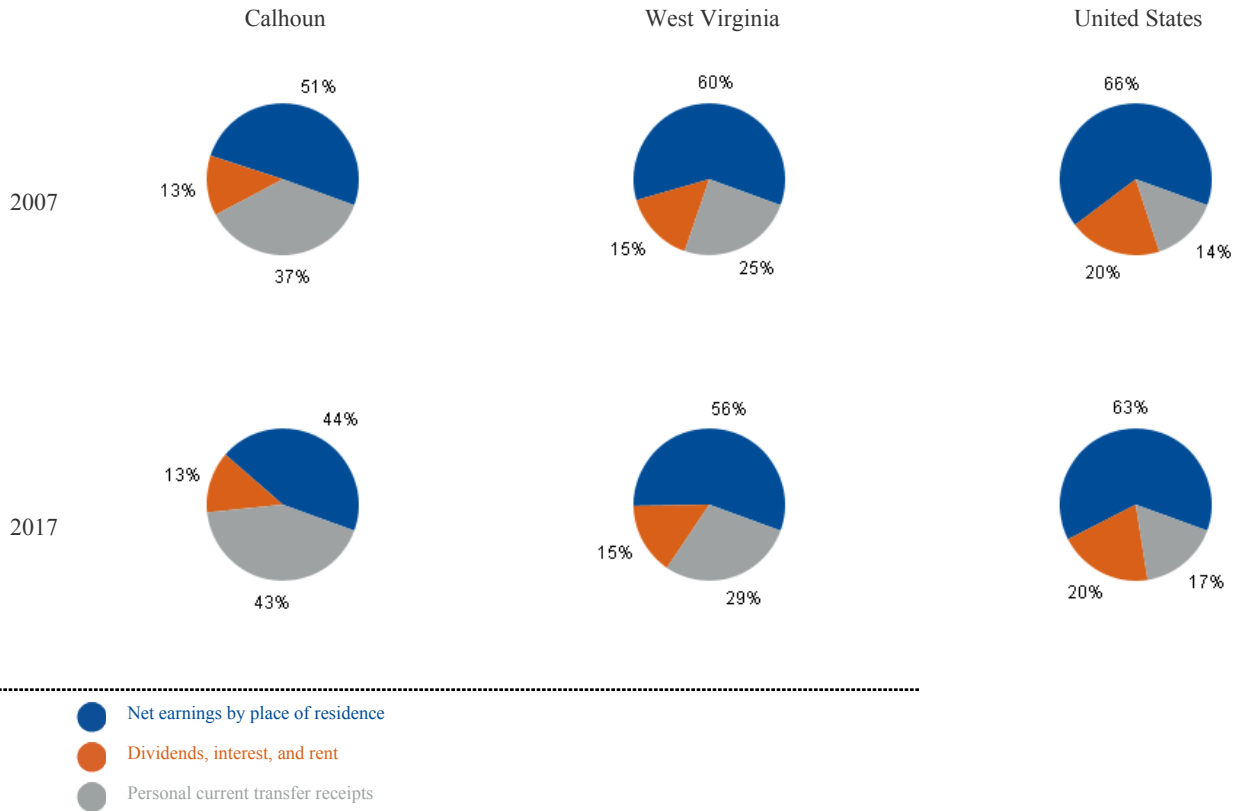
