Qualified seniors may begin graduate study early through the University's senior petition policy. Senior petition only applies to courses numbered 400-599. This form must be approved prior to or at the time of enrollment.

To qualify, a student must:

- Be classified as a Senior.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 on a 4.0 scale.

Credit policies:

- Coursework may not be counted for both undergraduate and graduate credit.
- The maximum number of hours of graduate credit permitted by senior petition is 15 credit hours
