

Undergraduate Application to Enroll in 500-Level Courses

Advanced undergraduate students may request permission to enroll in a graduate course numbered 500-599. Undergraduate students may not enroll in 600 or above level courses.

To qualify, a student must:

- Be classified as either a Junior or Senior.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 on a 4.0 scale.

Credit policies:

- To request permission for graduate credit, complete the Senior Petition to Earn Graduate Credit.
- Coursework may not be counted for both undergraduate and graduate credit.
